Pursuant to California Government Code section 6253, the City of Riverside hereby submits its response to your request of April 2, 2012. In said request, you seek the disclosure of all expenditures and accounting for any outside legal representation/counsel, including the City Attorney's discretionary spending for outside legal counsel. More specifically, you are requesting an accounting in similar format to that which the City provided for the former City Manager's discretionary spending.

Please be advised that there is no such accounting that has been prepared and the law does not impose any duty to create such a record that does not exist at the time of the request. We are therefore denying your request since no such accounting has been prepared. You may wish to consider refining your request for non-privileged and disclosable public records possessed by the City of Riverside.
